





What is Access for All?

Access for All provides Internet access via a mobile hotspot called a Kajeet. These hotspots allows Springfield Public School students access to educational resources anywhere, anytime.



Who can apply for Access for All?

Springfield Public School students attending an IGNITE school who do not have Internet access at home may apply for the Kajeet hotspots.



How do I apply for Access for All?

Applications for Kajeet hotspots may be picked up and returned to the library. Applications require a parent or guardian signature for non-independent students.



What is the approval process for Access for All?

Applicants must demonstrate need and agree that they do not currently have Internet access at home. Hot spots are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.



Access for All Terms and Conditions

- Kajeet hotspots have a maximum of 500 MB per day.
- Kajeet hotspots are filtered for educational use only. Social media such as Facebook, Twitter, Snapchat, etc. cannot be accessed.
- Kajeet hotspot usage is monitored to ensure hotspots are being used appropriately. Students who have hotspots with low usage or inappropriate content will be required to return the device. Discipline action may follow for inappropriate use.
- Loss of the Kajeet hotspot will result in a \$150.00 fine.
- If a student gains Internet access at home, the Kajeet hot spot should be returned to the library immediately.
